Dear Dr. Missbach,


We refer to your letters to Messrs. Walter Kielholz, Brady Dougan, Hans-Ulrich Doerig, Tobias Guldemann, Kai Nargolwala, and John Tobin-de la Puente, dated September 16, 2008 in connection with the Toka Tindung project.

As we have communicated to you previously, Credit Suisse has been in discussions with the company with regard to providing finance for this project. However, Credit Suisse has not committed to provide such financing so far.


Credit Suisse is aware of the potential environmental and social impacts of this particular project. Any commitment by Credit Suisse to provide financing will ultimately depend upon a number of factors, including approval of all relevant Credit Suisse internal committees and approval by the Indonesian Ministry of Environment and the Governor of North Sulawesi, as well as evidence that the project complies not only with all applicable laws and regulations but also with the Equator Principles, a common approach by leading banks to address ecological and social risks in project finance.
